Views on infrastructure/ Experience

- Prior to Rishi Sunak MP's tenure as Chancellor he held the positions of Private Secretary for BEIS, the Under Secretary of State for Local Government and the Chief Secretary to the Treasury.
- As Chancellor, Sunak has provided billions to support infrastructure in the UK. This includes the £100 billion National Infrastructure Strategy in 2020 and the £12 billion capital launch of the UK Infrastructure Bank in 2021.
- Sunak launched the Infrastructure Pipeline in 2021 which set out how £650 billion of private and public investment will be used to support infrastructure projects over the 2020s.
